The 2013 *Click It or Ticket* enforcement mobilization runs from November 26 through December 1.

As the busy Holiday season kicks off and Stratford motorists take to the roads, it is important that everyone buckles up every time they go out, both day and night – no excuses.

While belt use nationwide hit a record high of 86 percent in 2012, according to the U.S. Department of Transportation's National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, there are still thousands of vehicle drivers and passengers who are not buckling up – and the result can be tragic. NHTSA statistics show that in 2011, 21,253 passenger vehicle occupants were killed in motor vehicle crashes and 52 percent were not wearing their seat belts at the time of the crash.

In the interest of public safety and as a partner in this year's *Click It or Ticket* mobilization, **The Stratford Police Department** increasing enforcement efforts to save more lives on our roadways. Motorists are **urged** to fasten their seat belts, day and night, for each and every trip; and encourage your loved ones to always buckle up too ... you could save them the cost of a ticket, and even their life. *Click It or Ticket*.

The message to the public is: "With the 2013 Holiday travel period fast approaching, Connecticut's law enforcement agencies intend to promote safe driving and increase the protection of all motorists."
