Stratford Police Department General Fingerprinting

Effective July 26, 2022 fingerprinting for Citizens of Stratford with a valid I.D. will resume during the following scheduled hours;

- Mondays and Wednesdays from 1800 to 2000 hours.
- Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays from 0900 to 1100 hours.
- No fingerprinting will be done on Town Holidays.
- 1. Face mask is optional.
- 2. Fingerprints will be done on the IDEMIA machine. The employer or agency that is requesting the citizen to be fingerprinted should supply them with a 'Service Code.' If they have not received a 'Service Code,' the citizen should call the CT State Police Bureau of Identification at # 860-685-8480 to be issued one. This code should then be entered on the following link: https://ct.flexcheck.us.idemia.io/CCHRSPreEnroll/. This will provide them with a 'Transaction Number' which will be needed from the citizen in order to print them on the IDEMIA machine.
- 3. Once the citizen has registered via the above mentioned online link and has received a 'Transaction Number,' the citizen can come to the Stratford Police Department during the above mentioned hours in order to get fingerprinted.
- 4. Ink cards will no longer be accepted by the state for employment.
- 5. For those town residents that are required by a government agency or out of state employer to be fingerprinted on Applicant FD-258 (blue FBI card), notify the Desk Sergeant and a card will be provided to you to pass along to agency or employer.
- 6. The Stratford Police Department will update the Town fingerprint general policy as directed by the Chief of Police and as directed by the State of Connecticut.
