

# Stratford Police Department News Release

For Immediate Release: 06-30-14

On Thursday, July 3<sup>rd</sup> 2014, the Town of Stratford will hold its annual fireworks at Short Beach. The following traffic pattern will be used to exit Lordship after the fireworks display:

All traffic exiting the parking lots of Avco, traffic will be directed **North** on Main St. Vehicles exiting Short Beach will be directed to use both lanes of Dorne Dr to exit the parking lot. **NO TRAFFIC WILL GO NORTH.**

**BOTH** traffic lanes (**GREEN ARROW**) will be directed up to Stratford Rd then left onto Stratford Road, and will continue straight down Stratford Rd. to Lordship Blvd. (Burma Road)

All traffic from the residential area will be directed down Short Beach Rd. to on Lighthouse Ave, then right on Prospect Dr. to the intersection of Stratford Rd and Prospect Dr.. At this point, traffic will be required to wait until the beach parking lot has been significantly cleared. Once cleared, Officers will send this traffic into the same exit pattern.

Lordship Blvd will be closed to eastbound traffic from Access Rd to Oak Bluff Ave until traffic flow returns to normal. Residents will be allowed to enter Lordship until the start of the Fireworks (2130hrs) at which time it will be emergency access only.

**Once the exit pattern begins there will be NO ACCESS permitted on Lordship Blvd (Burma Road) and all of Stratford Rd.**
